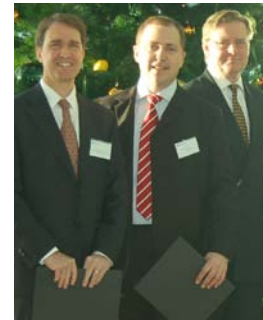


Notable Achievements
